



Statistics = a growth trend @ your library

- + 15% increase in check outs from 2006 to 2007
- + 51,300 library items were checked out to you;
  29,678 various resources on your library shelves
- + \$1,282,500 worth of resources taken home (average \$25 per item) □
- + 48,612 additional items used in the library and on-line
- + 3,260 of you are library cardholders representing about 30% of the township's population



- + 30,576 people came through ours doors
- + 5,304 visits to our public computers
- + 7,384 electronic visits to the library
- resources are 10 years newer than 2005
- + 29% more programming; 34% increase in attendance
- + 66% more kids in the Summer Reading Club
