- 17% increase in check outs from 2007 to 2008
- 58,477 library items were checked out to you; 28,210 various resources on your library shelves
- + \$1.461.925 worth of resources taken home (average \$25 per item)
- + 51.050 additional items used in the library and on-line
- + 3,300 of you are library cardholders representing about 34% of the township's population
- 31,400 people came through our +doors
- 6,000 visits to our public computers +
- 19,648 website visits to the library
- 40 extra programmes with 359 participants coordinated through our Lakes & Islands Lifelong Learning Project



- spearheaded the first annual Escott Spring Thing
- wireless internet is a hit with our summer residents
- more and more movies, music and audio-books
- many new titles in large print; new magazines
- new on-line Novelist = readers' advisory for avid readers
- we provided free public internet/computer lessons
