### 1.0 Preamble

1.1 Bylaws are the fundamental governing rules of the library board. The Library Board will review the bylaws during the first year of its term, as part of the orientation and training process. The purpose of this bylaw is to state the conditions under which bylaws are amended.

### 2.0 Amendments to Bylaws

- 2.1 Bylaws may be amended in response to legislation or when the circumstances of the Library or Board change significantly enough to merit an update.
- 2.2 At a board meeting any member can propose a review or an amendment of a bylaw.
- 2.3 Before an amendment can take place, all members of the library board will receive notice and a draft of proposed changes. The draft must be received for review at least one (1) week prior to the board meeting at which a motion for amendment will be tabled.
- 2.4 A motion to add, amend or remove a bylaw shall require a majority vote of at least two thirds of the members in order to be carried.
- 2.5 The board may strike an ad-hoc committee to review the bylaws and make recommendations at any time.
